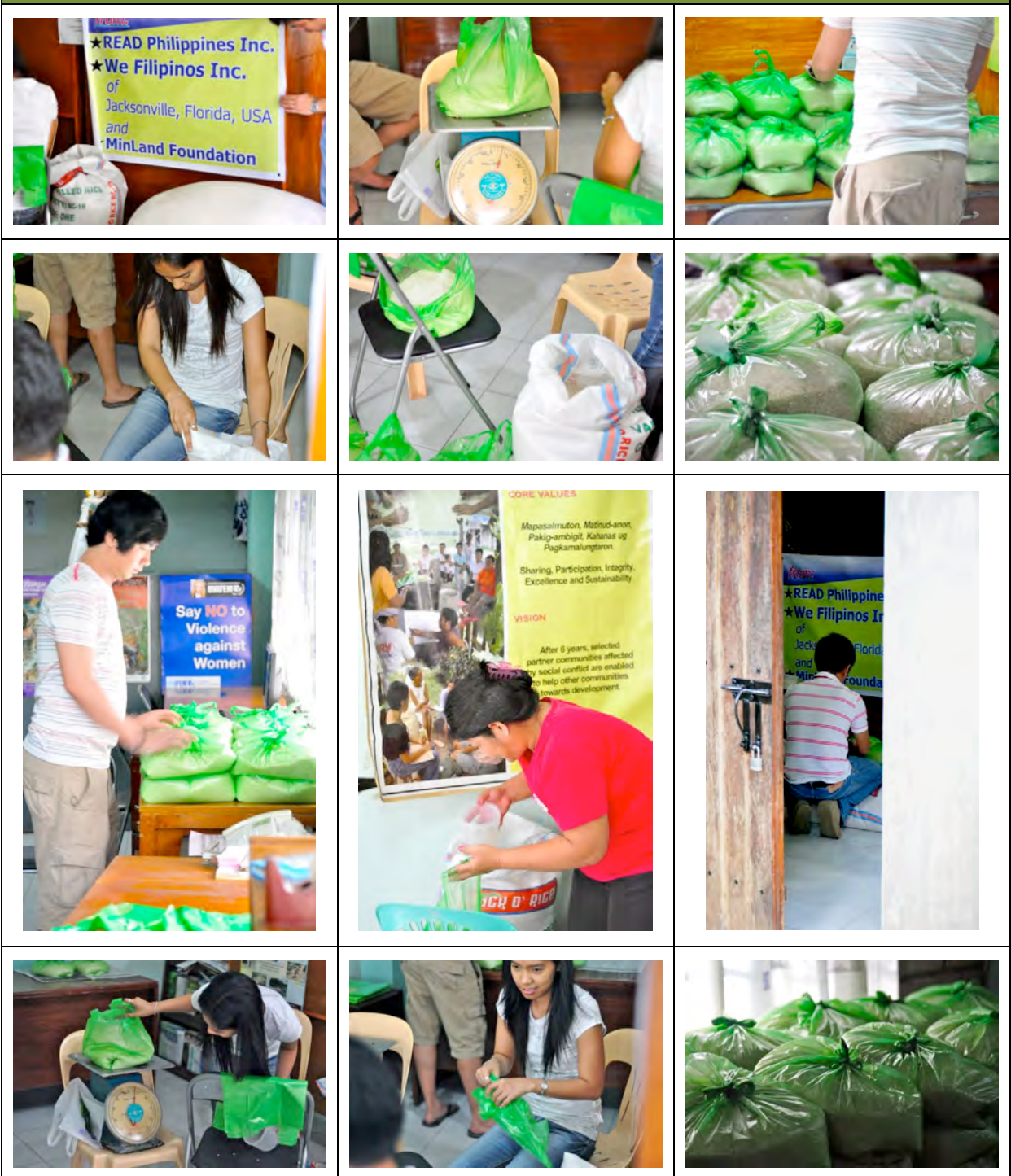

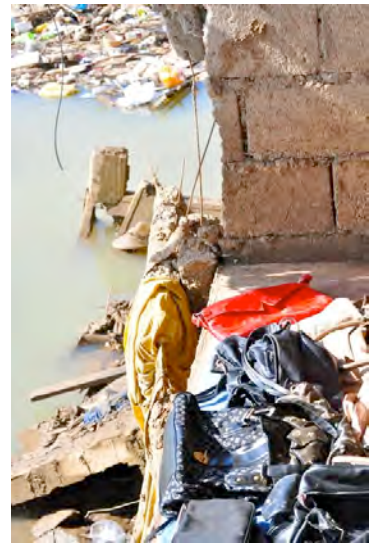

Selected recipients of the relief packs were families whose houses were completely washed out, damaged or rendered uninhabitable by the flash flood. Those houses with some walls and posts surviving were emptied of its contents by the high raging waters.

Recipient families were not the poorest of the poor but the flood rendered them bereft of basic necessities (food, water, shelter, clothing, electricity, and others) at the time of the relief operations. Setting aside what remains of their dignity, they braved lining up to receive the help being offered them. The Barangay officials and its staff, together with Ms. Jo Andot did good preparatory work to keep the distribution orderly; people kept their self-respect.

While the relief packs were modest, the recipients expressed sincere gratefulness for the goods including the bottled water provided by the family of Ms. Jo Andot. The Barangay Chairman also expressed his appreciation and thanks for the initiative and support coming from as far as Jacksonville, Florida, USA.

We continue to pray for guidance and support to those affected by the flooding brought about by Typhoon Sendong especially after the outpouring of relief and emergency support from everywhere ends. The recovery phase in the aftermath of the calamity will surely be much more challenging.
